

Fuel Excise Duty Rates Increase From 5 August 2024

From 5 August 2024, fuel and petroleum excise duty rates will increase. You can find the new rates at ato.gov.au/fuelexciserates.

This increase in duty rates also increases the fuel tax credit rates applicable from 5 August 2024. The new duty rates are below, and can also be found on the ATO website at https://www.ato.gov.au/businesses-and-organisations/income-deductions-andconcessions/incentives-and-concessions/fuel-schemes/fuel-tax-credits-business/ratesbusiness/from-1-july-2024-to-30-june-2025. The rate is applicable on the date you acquired the fuel.

Blended fuels: B5, B20, E10 Unit: cents per litre	20.1 (see <u>note 3</u>)	50.6
Blended fuel: E85 Unit: cents per litre	0	21.7
Liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) (duty paid) Unit: cents per litre	0	16.5

Fuel tax credit rates are indexed twice a year, in February and August.
